

RESOLUTION NO. R07-073

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF HILLSBOROUGH COUNTY, FLORIDA, TRANSMITTING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AFFAIRS PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE FUTURE OF HILLSBOROUGH COMPREHENSIVE PLAN FOR UNINCORPORATED HILLSBOROUGH COUNTY, AS ADOPTED BY ORDINANCE 89-28, AS AMENDED, CHANGING THE USE OF LAND WITHIN THE COUNTY AND CHANGING THE TEXT OF THE PLAN.

Upon motion by Commissioner Sharpe, seconded by Commissioner Perlita, the following resolution was adopted by a vote of 6 to 0; Commissioner(s) voting "No."

WHEREAS, the Hillsborough County Board of County Commissioners adopted a Comprehensive Plan for Unincorporated Hillsborough County entitled *Future of Hillsborough Comprehensive Plan for Unincorporated Hillsborough County* pursuant to Section 163.3161, Florida Statutes, on July 12, 1989 (Ordinance 89-28); and

WHEREAS, Section 163.3187, Florida Statutes, provides for amendments to the Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, following a public hearing on January 22, 2007, on proposed Plan Amendments, the Hillsborough County City-County Planning Commission recommended certain proposed Amendments to the Future of Hillsborough Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 163.3187, Florida Statutes, the Hillsborough County Board of County Commissioners considered at a public hearing held on April 19, 2007, and April 26, 2007 the proposed Amendments to the Future of Hillsborough Comprehensive Plan summarized below:

<b>Text/Map Amendment</b>	<b>Plan Elements</b>	<b>Description and Purpose of Proposed Text Amendment</b>
HC CPA 06-28	Transportation	Provides for amendment to the Hillsborough County Corridor Plan for the purpose of identifying future transportation corridors.
HC CPA 07-03	Future Land Use	Provides for designation of Wimauma Village Plan including its Vision, Goals, Strategies and for creation of and designation of land to Wimauma Village Residential - 2 (WVR - 2) Future Land Use category.

Provides for a decrease in the allowable density and intensity along portions of the Alafia River and for the designation of areas for mixed-use development along portions of the Alafia River.

and

WHEREAS, Section 163.3184, Florida Statutes, provides that the local government shall, following an advertised public hearing, transmit by affirmative vote of not less than a majority of the members of the governing body present at the hearing, proposed comprehensive plan amendments to the Department of Community Affairs for written comment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF HILLSBOROUGH COUNTY, FLORIDA, AT A PUBLIC HEARING HELD THIS 26th DAY OF APRIL, 2007:

1. That the Board of County Commissioners of Hillsborough County, Florida, hereby transmits to the Department of Community Affairs for written comments, objections and recommendations the above-described proposed Plan Amendments for the *Future of Hillsborough Comprehensive Plan for Unincorporated Hillsborough County*. The text of the transmittal has been placed on file with the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners and is incorporated by reference as an integral part of this resolution.

2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
