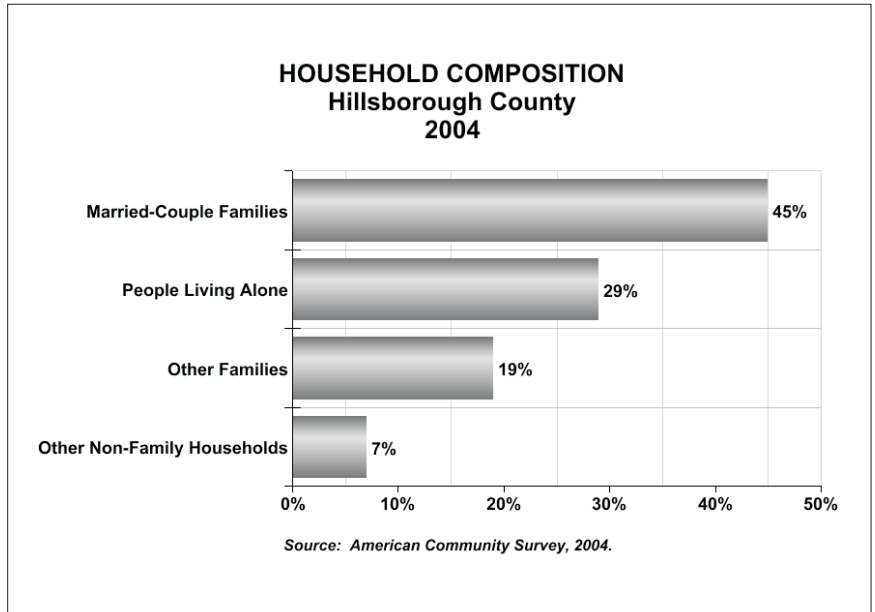

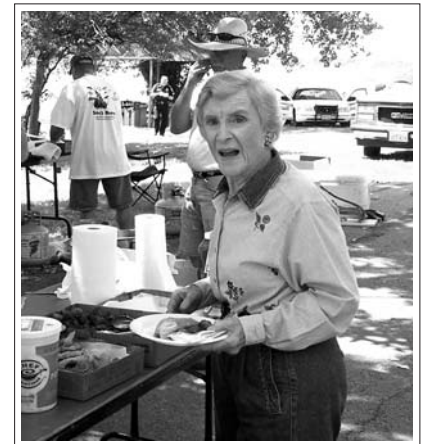
HOUSEHOLDS AND FAMILIES

Hillsborough County is home to 434,000 households (2004). Family households make up 64 percent of the county's total households. Of the total number of households in the county, 45 percent are married-couple households and 19 percent are "Other" families. Non-family households comprised 36 percent of the total households in the county in 2004. The majority of the non-family households were people living alone and the remainder were composed of unrelated persons living in households.

- According to the 2004 American Community Survey, the median income of households in Hillsborough County was \$44,324 compared to \$41,324 in 2003. The State of Florida's median income in 2004 was \$41,236 and that of the nation was \$44,684.
- In 2004, 82 percent of Hillsborough County's households received earnings and 17 percent received retirement income other than social security. Twenty-five percent of the county's household received social security in 2004.



- The average income from social security in Hillsborough County 2004 was \$12,974.
- The average household size in Hillsborough County in 2003 was 2.6 persons compared to 2.5 persons in 2004.
- The population under 18 years totaled 280,868 in Hillsborough County in 2004. Out of the 280,868 people, 98.8 percent or 277,430 lived in family households, 175,698 or 62.6 percent in married-couple family households and 1.2 percent, or 3,438 percent lived in non-family households.
- The median income for a married-couple family in Hillsborough County in 2004 was \$66,667 compared to the nations' median income of \$63,137.



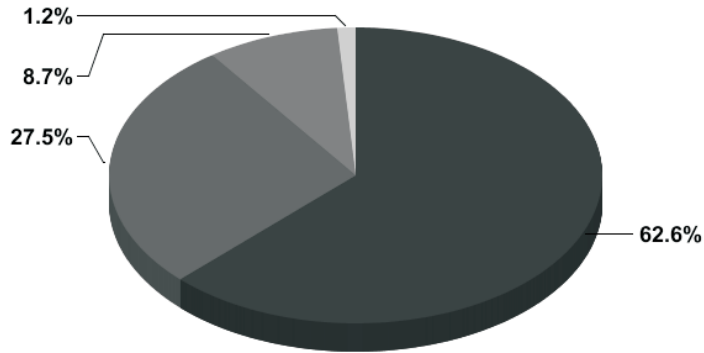
- In 2004, 84 percent of Hillsborough County's population (25 years and over) had at least graduated from high school, and 29 percent had a bachelor's degree.

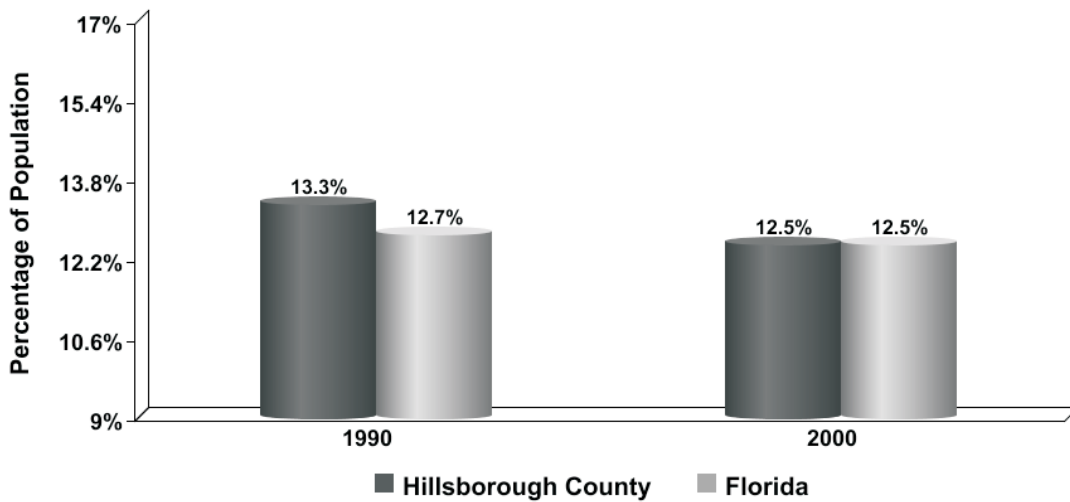
**PERCENT OF POPULATION 18 YEARS IN FAMILY HOUSEHOLD BY

- Non-family households

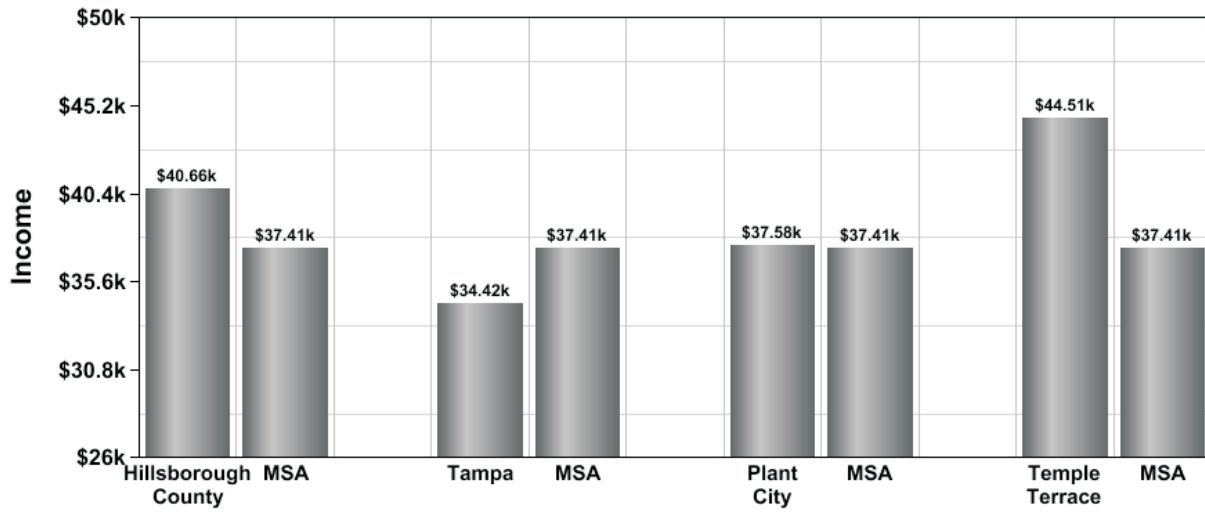
