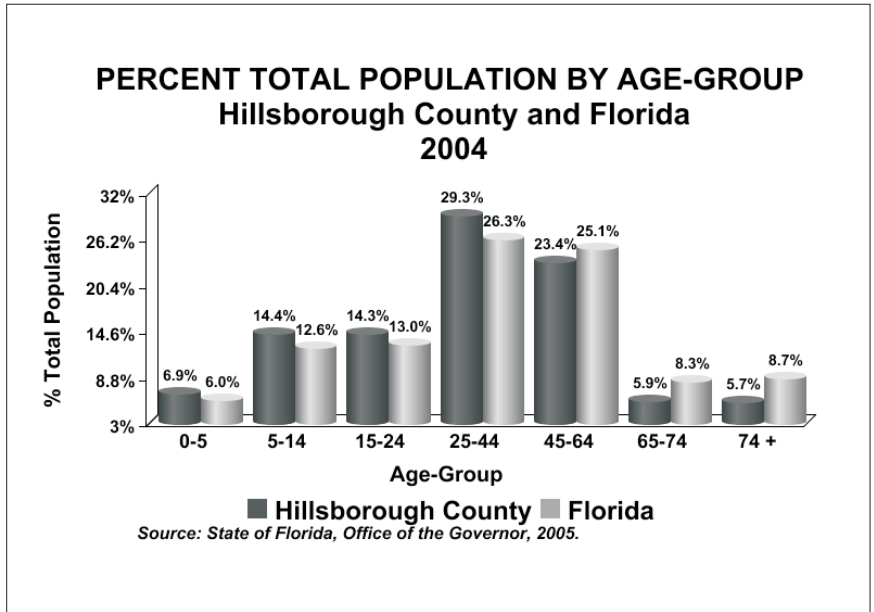

POPULATION TRENDS

HILLSBOROUGH COUNTY

Hillsborough County's population reached 1,177,060 in 2006. The City of Tampa, the largest of the incorporated cities in Hillsborough County accounted for 28 percent, or 334,550 of the County's total population in 2006. **The number of people living in Hillsborough County is projected to reach 1,537,290 by the year 2025.** Hillsborough County's population grew at an annual average percent change of 2.8 percent from the year 2000 to 2006. Population density per square mile continued to rise in Hillsborough County. In 2006, the population density per square mile in the County reached 1,100 persons per square miles versus 1,087 persons per square miles in 2004. The County's average annual percentage growth rate in population from the year 2000 through the year 2004 was 2.8 percent compared to 2.3 percent for the State of Florida and 1.9 percent for the Tampa-St. Pete. Clearwater Metropolitan Statistical Area. The median age of Hillsborough County's population in 2005 was 35.9 years.

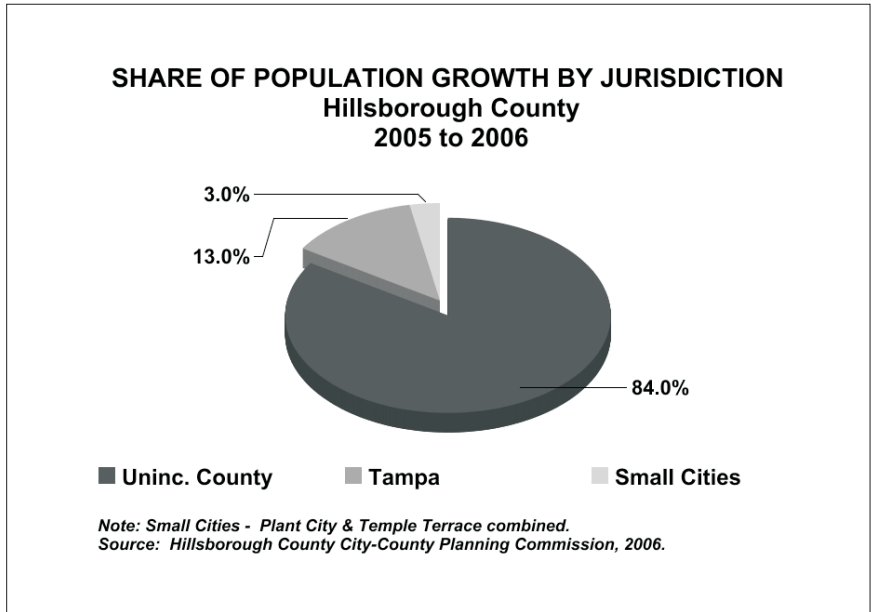


- Hillsborough County's racial and ethnic mix is composed of 74 percent Whites, 16 percent Black or African Americans, 0.4 percent American Indian and Alaska Native, 3 percent Asian, 0.1 percent Native Hawaiian and Other Pacific Islander, and 6.5 percent are Other races.
- Hispanics made up 21.4 percent of the population in Hillsborough County in 2005 and White Hispanics accounted for 58.5 percent of the County's 2005 population. People of Hispanic origin may be of any race.
- Growth in Hispanic population increased from 179,692 in 2000 to 237,601 in 2005, an increase of 57,909 people.
- The county's Asian population represented one of the fastest growing ethnic population from the year 2000 to 2005. The county's Asian population rose from 21,947 in 2000 to 32,978 in 2005, an increase of 50.2 percent.



- The County's Hispanic population in the 18-34 age group is projected to grow from 51,464 in 2000 to 88,764 in 2015, an increase of 72.4 percent.
- The largest population age group in Hillsborough County in 2005 was the 35-54-year age group, which accounted for 29.3 percent of the county's 2005 total population. The 35-54 age group accounted for 28.2 percent of the State of Florida's 2005 population (17.9 million).

- Persons age 65 years and over accounted for 11.6 percent of Hillsborough County's population in 2005, while Florida's percent share in the same age category was 17.3 percent.



- The population in Hillsborough County's 65-79 age group is projected to increase from 89,572 people in 2000 to 139,020 people in 2015, an increase of 55.2 percent.

- Non-Hispanic Black population in Hillsborough County is projected to grow from 148,560 in 2000 to 250,653 in 2015, an increase of 68.7 percent.

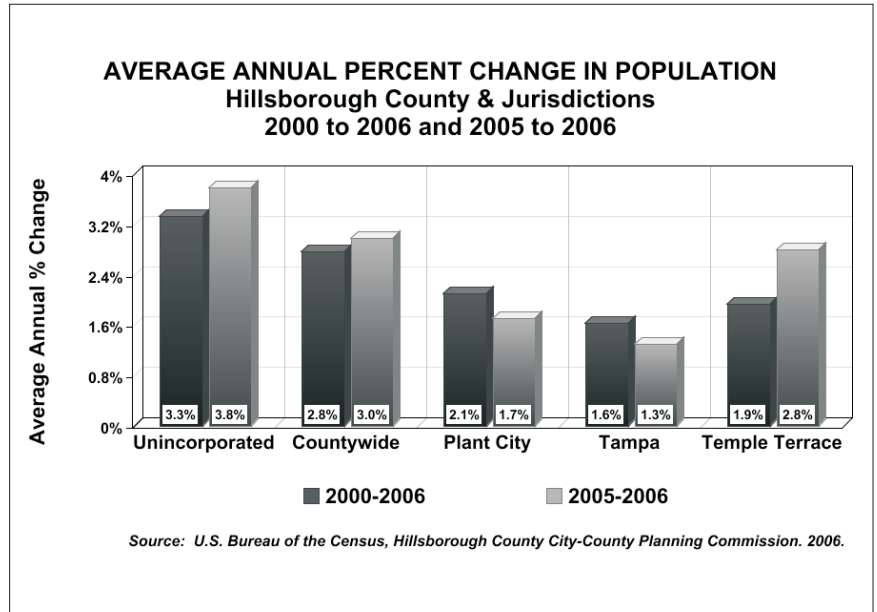
- Foreign-born residents accounted for 13.9 percent of Hillsborough County's population in 2005. Eighty-six percent of the county's population was native and 38.4 percent Florida residence.

- Twenty-three percent of the county's population (five years and older) spoke a language other than English at home. Of those speaking a language other than English at home, 18.2 percent spoke Spanish and 8.7 percent spoke some other language.



UNINCORPORATED HILLSBOROUGH COUNTY

The unincorporated Hillsborough County covers 923 square miles of land area with a population density of 851 persons per square miles (2006 population estimates). The unincorporated Hillsborough County has accounted for most of Hillsborough County's new growth since the 1980s. Population in the unincorporated Hillsborough County rose from 644,668 in 2000 to 785,120 in 2006. This new milestone in the unincorporated Hillsborough County's population increase in 2006 represented a 21.7 percent increase from year 2000. The unincorporated Hillsborough County's 2006 population (785,120) accounted for 66.7 percent of Hillsborough County's 2006 population (1,177,060).



- *Between the year 2000 and the year 2006, the area's population grew at an average annual rate of 3.3 percent.*
- ***The population for the unincorporated area is projected to reach 1,032,950 persons by the year 2025.***
- *Among the populated communities in the unincorporated area are Brandon, Carrollwood, Greater Sun City Center, Riverview, Westchase, Balm/Wimauma and Town & Country.*
- *Among the four jurisdictions in Hillsborough County, the Unincorporated Hillsborough County had the largest average annual percent growth rate in population from the year 2000 to 2006, when compared to the City of Plant City, City of Tampa and the City of Temple Terrace.*
- *The average annual percent change in population in the unincorporated area from the year 2000 to 2006 was 3.3 percent. The countywide average-annual-percent change in population for the same period was 2.77 percent.*



CITY OF TAMPA

The City of Tampa is Hillsborough County's largest municipality covering a land area of 117.1 square miles and a 2006 population of 334,550 persons. Population density in the city rose from 2,794 persons per square miles in 2004 to 2,857 persons per square miles in 2006. The city's median age in 2004 was estimated at 35.6 years compared to 34.7 years in 2000. Between the year 2000 and 2006, the City of Tampa's population grew at an average annual growth rate of 1.6 percent compared to a countywide growth rate of 2.8 percent. Population in the City of Tampa increased from 303,447 in 2000 to 334,550 in 2006. The City of Tampa's population grew by an average annual absolute change of 5,184 people from the year 2000 to 2006. ***The population for the City of Tampa is projected to reach 425,900 persons by the year 2025.***



- *Persons aged between 25-34 years accounted for the largest age group in the city's 2004 population. This age group accounted for 12.2 percent of the city's population in 2004.*
- *Between the year 2000 and 2006, the City of Tampa's population grew at an annual average percent ate of 1.6 percent.*
- *Populated communities in the City of Tampa include **New Tampa** and **south Tampa**. Population in the City of Tampa is projected to reach 425,900 persons by the year 2025.*
- *Ten percent of the City of Tampa's population in 2004 was foreign-born and 90 percent was Native, including 45 percent who were born in Florida.*
- *In 2004, the age composition of the City's population included 19 percent of people who were 65 years and over and 31 percent of the population in the 25-44 age group.*
- *The City of Tampa's Hispanic population numbered 67,540 in 2004, accounting for 22 percent of the City's 2004 population.*
- *The number of housing units reached 145,730 units in the City of Tampa in 2004 and continued to grow in 2005 (147,870 units). New residential developments in the city's Central Business District (CBD), particularly in the Channelside District and an increasing number of in-fill development in south Tampa accounted for a majority of the new housing units recorded in 2005.*



CITY OF PLANT CITY

The City of Plant City is known for its annual strawberries and Union. Plant City currently covers a land area of 22.9 square miles with a population density of 1,481 persons per square mile. This figure is based on the city's 2006 population of 33,910 people. Plant City was home to 33,340 persons in 2005, and the city's population is projected to grow to 49,040 persons by the year 2025. Plant City's population is projected to increase 2.5 percent in 10 years, while the county's population is projected to grow at 2 percent at the same period. The City of Plant City's share of Hillsborough County's total population in 2006 was 2.9 percent.

- *Between the year 2000 and 2006, the City of Plant City's population grew at an average annual percent change of 2.11 percent.*
- *In 2006, the Plant City's population rose to 33,910 people. This figure represented a 13.3 percent increase from the year 2000 population of 29,915 people.*
- *The number of housing units in the City of Plant City rose from 11,797 units in 2000 to 13,410 units in 2006.*
- *Total households in the city grew from 8,395 in 1990 to 10,849 in 2000. Households with married couple families accounted for 52.7 percent of households in 2000.*



CITY OF TEMPLE TERRACE

The City of Temple Terrace is the smallest, but most densely populated incorporated-city in Hillsborough County. The city covers 6.9 square miles of land and had a population density of 3,403 persons per square mile based on its 2006 population of 23,480 people. The city's population density of 3,403 persons per square mile makes it the most densely populated jurisdiction in Hillsborough County. Population in the city rose from 22,480 people in 2004 to 23,480 people in 2006. ***The population of the City of Temple Terrace is projected to reach 29,400 people by the year 2025.***

- *Between the year 2000 and 2006, the City of Temple Terrace's population grew at an average annual percent change of 1.9 percent.*
- *The City of Temple Terrace's 2006 population (23,480) accounted for 2.0 percent of Hillsborough County's 2006 population (1,177,060).*

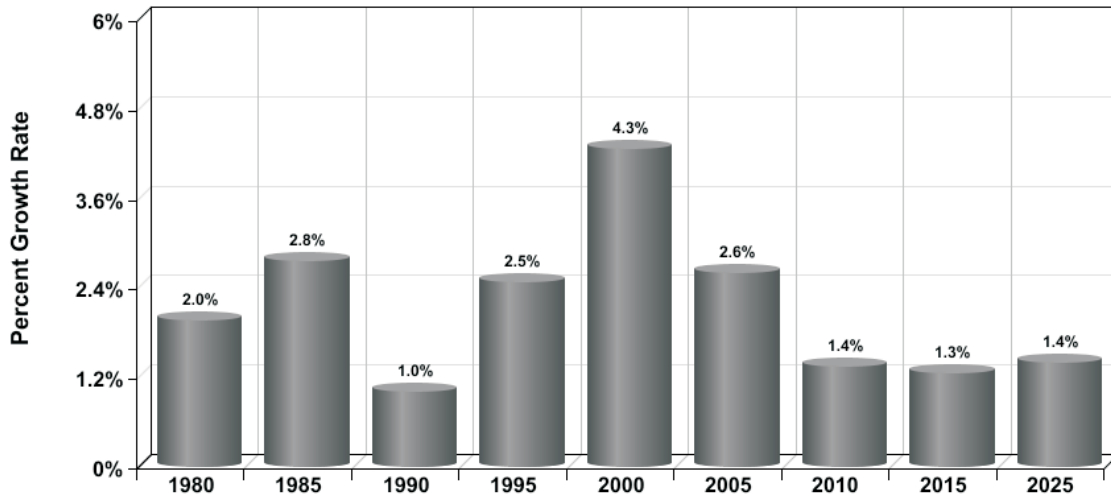

1980 - 2025**



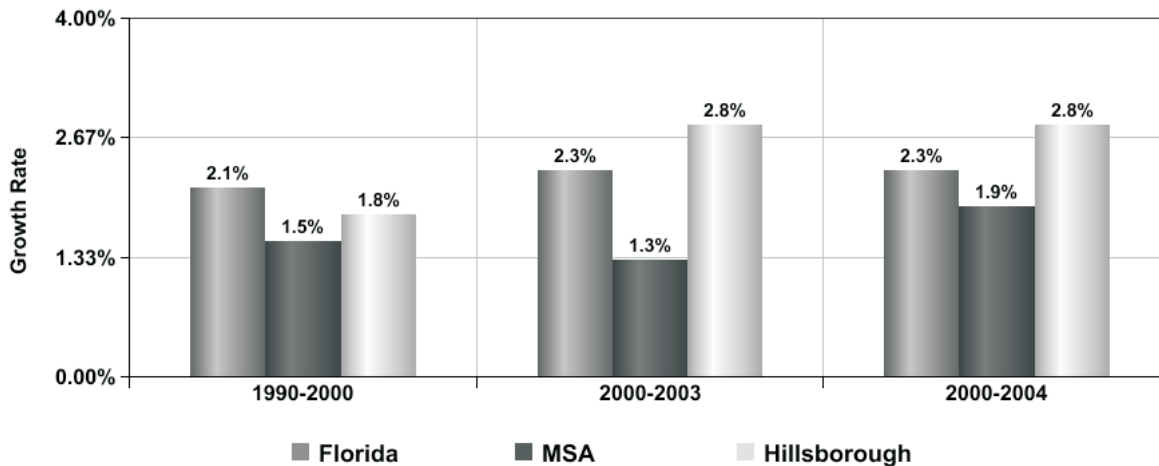

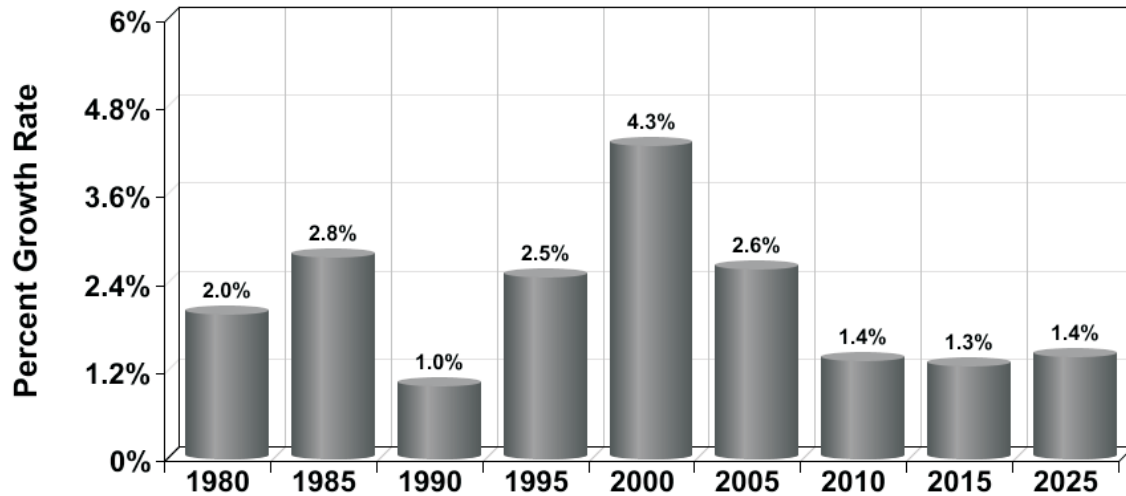
**AVERAGE ANNUAL PERCENTAGE GROWTH RATE

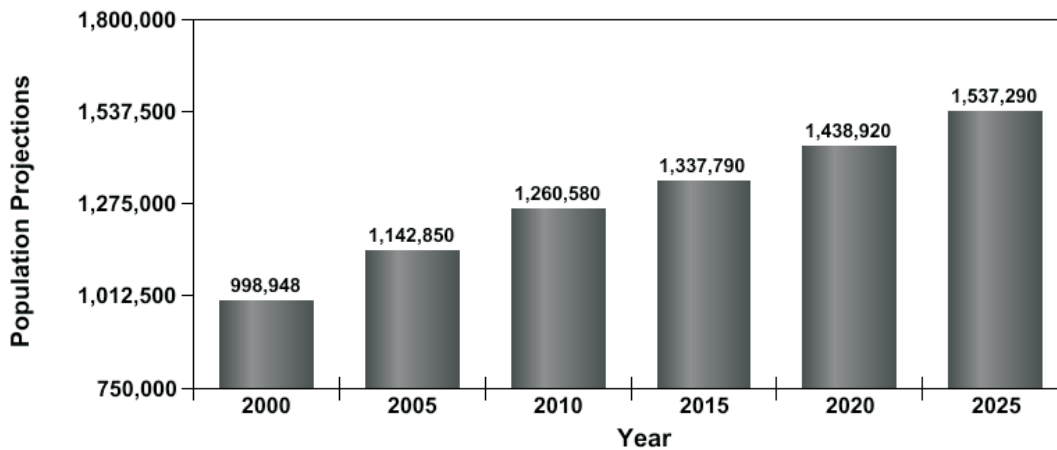
